

Scholarship Program

Abri Credit Union believes strongly in giving back to our members and the communities we serve. Abri Credit Union's Scholarship Program has been established to recognize, reward and help make possible the pursuit of higher education by members.

Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded--One to a graduating high school senior, one to an existing higher education student.

Who Is Eligible?

- •You are eligible to apply if you or your parent(s) have been an Abri Credit Union member in good standing for 6 months prior to the date of your application. Your accounts (checking, ATM, savings, etc.) must be in good standing with no delinquent or charge off loans.
- •a graduating high school senior, who has been accepted as a full-time student at an accredited college, university or vocational school for 2014-2015

Or

- •a full-time student currently enrolled in an accredited college, university or vocational school for 2014-2015
- •minimum GPA of 2.5 out of 4.0 or 3.5 out of 5.0 or higher

Abri board members and employees and their immediate families are not eligible.

How Are Recipients Selected?

ACU scholarships will be awarded to members who submit the best 60-second video/commercial that conveys a clear, clever message of their financial knowledge on one of the following topics:

- •What do you wish someone would have told you before you started handling money?
- •What 3 qualities do you think are important for a financial institution to have?
- •What are some ways you could cut back in order to save money?

We will not judge the quality of the production, but the message itself.

Distribution of Award

ACU will award the \$1,000 scholarships in the form of a cashier's check payable to the student and the school. Winners will be notified by email on May 5, 2014.

How to Apply

You are required to submit a completed application, transcript, 60-second video and letters of recommendation. You can complete the application and upload documentation online at idmyway.com.
